Rhino, Oxpecker + Nutria

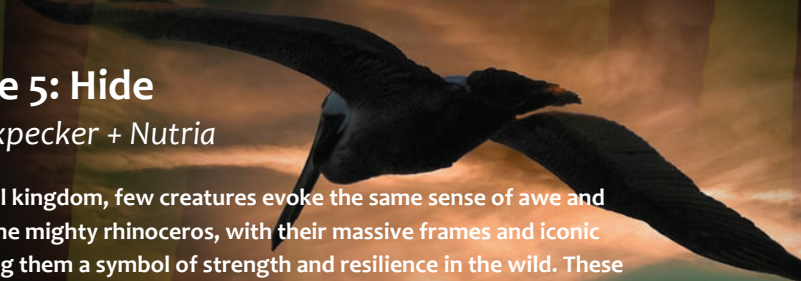

Episode 8: Speed

Cheetah, Sailfish, Peregrine Falcon + Horsefly

Episode 9: Faces

Tamarins, Marmoset, Capuchins, Spider Monkey + Snow Monkey

Episode 12: Formal

Penguins

Episode 12: Grace

Turtles, Jelly Fish + Manatee
