# THE MOST NOTORIOUS BETRAYERS, AND THE ELABORATE TRAPS THAT TOOK THEM DOWN...

What motivates someone to betray their own people? To be disloyal? Money? Ego? Idealism? **Traitor/Patriot** unravels the intricate stories of people who committed espionage against the countries or companies they were meant to protect. Each episode tells a different tale of betrayal, analyzes the secretive methods utilized by the traitors to accomplish their missions, and how intelligence agencies outsmarted them to catch them in the act and bring them to justice. The creators of our show were responsible for hunting down and catching the biggest spies in our country's history. From the FBI, CIA, U.S. Congress and international agencies, our counter intelligence experts will take viewers deep inside this game of cat and mouse, decipher the profile of a traitor, how they were caught, and what the actual and potential damage from each breach.



This will be our **sixth** project produced in co-operation with retired CIA and FBI executives and officers, and experts from other parts of the U.S. and allied governments. Our close relationship with these people allows us unprecedented access to national intelligence which drives the narratives of our shows. Our stories are told by the people who experienced the consequences of each traitor's espionage and had a firsthand role in bringing them to justice.







## MARK KELTON | EXECUTIVE PRODUCER



**Mark Kelton** served in senior positions at CIA for 34 years, ending his career as CIA's Chief of Counterintelligence where he was responsible for protecting the nation's most sensitive secrets - and hunting down the traitors who spied or acted on behalf of our enemies. A four-time CIA Station Chief, Mark is one of CIA's most decorated case officers and executives.

### **EPISODE 1 |** THE SOVIET GENERAL WHO SWITCHED SIDES



Arguably the greatest spy for the West during the Cold War, Dimitriy Polyakov was a Russian Military Intelligence General who turned on Russia. He was run by CIA and FBI and betrayed by both Ames and Hanssen (each traitors who betrayed America), he was brought out of retirement from his dacha and shot by Russian assassins.

### **EPISODE 2** | FRANCE'S MAN IN MOSCOW



A KGB Line X (technical espionage) officer who worked for the French internal service. He was the Subject of a movie - "Farewell" - that is worth seeing. The voluminous material he provided to the French was included in the so-called "Farewell Dossier" which was passed by French President Mitterrand to President Reagan. It contained tremendous information on Soviet Technical and economic espionage. He ultimately was caught after a bizarre incident involving his murder of a fellow KGB officer and his stabbing of a female KGB officer she was having an affair with.

### **EPISODE 3** | THE GENTLEMAN SPY: GEORGE BLAKE



George Blake was recruited to spy for the Soviets while a prisoner of the North Koreans during the Korean War -i.e. like the Manchurian candidate. Blake caused tremendous damage to MI6 and its allies around the world – including his blowing of the famed Berlin tunnel operation. He was ultimately found out, convicted, and sentenced to 42 years in prison. However, his subsequent escape from that prison with the help of an IRA prisoner and subsequent flight to Moscow is stranger than fiction.

# **EPISODE 4 | CHINA STEALS THE FUTURE**



In July 2018, the US charged a former Apple employee with theft of trade secrets. Xiaolang Zhang downloaded secret blueprints for a circuit board for Apple's self-driving car and tried to flee the US. Almost a year later, Jizhong Chen, a Chinese national, was charged with theft of trade secrets. He was one of 5,000 Apple employees who was looped in on the company's self-driving car effort, known as "Project Titan," which has been operating in secret for years. The U.S. has long suspected, and often accused, the Chinese government of encouraging trade secret theft as a way to build up its own industries.

# **EPISODE 5** | THE ROMEO PROJECT



Gabriele Kliem was one of those women recruited by East German intelligence officers posing as love interests. She worked as an interpreter at the US embassy in Bonn. Gabriele Gast, who worked for West German intelligence - the BND, was another. They were among several West German secretaries recruited the same way, that is by East German 'romeos' working at the behest of the so-called "Man without a Face"; East German (HVA) intel Chief Marcus Wolfe'. Wolfe was the model for many fictional spy villains during the Cold War.
